Materials Required for the Course:

**1. A DOUBLE ACTION REVOLVER OR ANY SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL. (Non-magnum)**

**All handguns brought to the course must be unloaded before entering the building.**

**NO MAGNUM AMMUNITION. Non-magnum** cartridges such as .357 Sig/10MM Auto/9X21/.400 Corbon, or similar are too powerful for the backstop of the range. **We STRONGLY suggest you become familiar with the handgun you will be shooting prior to the course. Continued unsafe practices may result in you being asked to leave the range. We do not allow single action revolvers, (cowboy style) in the course, in that they are slow to load and unload.**

**2. AMMUNITION**

Each student will be required to provide his/her own **factory** ammunition. **We STRONGLY SUGGEST using no lead or at least full metal jacket ammunition.** Hand loaded ammunition will not be allowed, as we have no assurance of safety or reliability with hand loads. We will be shooting a minimum of 150 rounds through the course. Ammunition will be checked by one of the instructors after you enter the building.

**3. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION**

Each student will be required to provide his/her own eye and ear protection while shooting in this class. Most prescription glasses will give you the protection needed for this class. If you do not wear glasses, you will need to obtain protective shooting glasses or safety glasses. These glasses do not need to be expensive. Inexpensive plastic shooting glasses are acceptable.

Hearing protection may be the simplest ear plugs to the most expensive electronic hearing earmuffs. We recommend that you purchase a decent set of muffs or plugs as gunshots can permanently damage hearing.

**4. CLEANING EQUIPMENT**

Each student will be required to provide his/her own basic cleaning kit. The kit can either be specialized for the handgun you bring to class or a general kit that will fit several types of handguns.

Minimum supplies for this kit should be:

- Carrying case or container for the cleaning kit.
- Cleaning rod that will fit the gun.
- Tips for the rod including a bore brush to fit the caliber and a bore patch tip.
- Solvent.
- Patches (soft cotton or other absorbent material).

Gun oil.

Medium sized towel. (This will get dirty so don't bring a good one)

Several rags. (Baby diapers or old towels work well)

We believe in having fun in our classes while learning and practicing safe gun handling procedures. This course does satisfy requirements for the Wyoming concealed firearm permit and there will be discussion of firearms and the law. **You will be notified by mail OR by phone confirming the specific class you will be attending.
