NRA APPROVED 80 SHOT HIGH POWER CLUB MATCH



DATE: Saturday June 13, July 11, August 15

TIME: 8:45 A.M. Squadding 9:00 A.M. Firing Commences

LOCATION: Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club Outdoor Range – 10 miles northwest of Cheyenne, WY. Go north on Interstate 25 to Exit 16, Horse Creek Road. West on Horse Creek Road for 3.3 miles to Telephone Road. North on Telephone Road For 2 miles. Turn East on dirt road for ½ mile to range gate. The match will be shot at the High-Power range.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules will apply.

OPEN BOLT FLAG: OBI/ECI required. Available for \$1.00 or may borrow one from the club. ECI must be inserted at all times except during the 3-minute prep and the timed match. ECI must be inserted at the conclusion of record fire.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to anyone 16 years of age and older. (15 and younger must be approved by match director)

FEES: \$20.00 (CHECKS PAYABLE TO Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club)

ENTRY: Entries will be received until 8:15 A.M. or to range capacity of 21

RIFLE: Current NRA High Power Rules will apply.

AMMO: Any Safe Ammo. **NO** tracer or incendiary.

COURSE OF FIRE: 2 sighter shots allowed before each match.

Match 1 – Slow Fire–200 Yards–20 Shots Standing–1 Min/Shot–Sling in Parade Position–Target SR

Match 2 – Rapid Fire–200 Yards–2 Strings of 10 Shots Sitting/Kneeling–60 Secs–Target SR

Match 3 – Rapid Fire–300 Yards–2 Strings of 10 Shots Prone–70 Secs–Target SR-3

Match 4 – Slow Fire–600 Yards–20 Shots Prone–1 Min/Shot–Target MR-1

GENERAL INFORMATION: The Shotmarker Electronic Targets System will be used. Competitors should bring an electronic device with sufficient power for a full day of operation and a browser capable of accessing an internal webpage over the Range WiFi. With the electronic target system, competitors are still required to score. Paid score keepers are not permitted. Competitors may be required to assist setting up and taking down targets; failure to do so may lead to disqualification. In the event of a catastrophic failure or malfunction of the electronic target system, the Match Director will reserve the right to either delay the match or to switch to manual targets. All competitors will be required to perform pit duties if such a case arises. If a substitute puller is used, the competitor shall accompany the substitute puller and is responsible for their attendance and performance in the pits. Please use our web site for updates.
