

# 9th Annual .22 Mid-Range National Championships 2026

**LOCATION:** Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club Outdoor Range – 10 miles northwest of Cheyenne, WY. Go north on Interstate 25 to Exit 16, Horse Creek Road. West on Horse Creek Road for 3.3 miles to Telephone Road. North on Telephone Road For 2 miles. Turn East on dirt road for ½ mile to range gate. The match will be shot at the High-Power range on East end of range. The electronic gate will be open to all access from 0700 till about 1000 when the gate will be closed and locked. When leaving the range, the gate will open without a code, please go slow to avoid hitting the gate.

## COURSES OF FIRE:

**ANY POSITION CHAMPIONSHIP.** Any position for all three targets, Sitting, standing, kneeling, prone or bench. See below for times, targets and rules.

**POSITION CHAMPIONSHIP.** 200-yard target shot off hand, 300-yard target shot sitting off cross sticks, may use a short stool with no arms, and the 600-yard target any position as above including bench. See below for times, targets and rules.

- A. Standard Mid-Range 200-yard SR target from 200 yards. 45 Minute relay for 15 record shots. 4 sighter shots including the first shot to cut paper.
- B. Reduced 300-yard SR-42 target from 200 yards. 45 Minute relay for 15 record shots. 4 sighter shots including the first shot to cut paper.
- C. Reduced 600-yard SR-52 target from 200 yards. 45 Minute relay for 15 record shots. 4 sighter shots including the first shot to cut paper.
- D. One single prep period per pit change. So, two shooters set up on fire point and prep together.

**RIFLES, EQUIPMENT, AND CLASSES:** .22 LR BPTRA Rifle (Meets BPTRA Classification) iron or scope sights. Any Position, prone, Cross Sticks, sitting on the ground or on a short stool with no back or arms. Bench shooters, use bench cross sticks and only the elbows and shoulder for rear support, no bags or any other type of artificial support. No wrist rest. ONLY BENCH SHOOTERS MAY USE BENCH CROSS STICKS, ALL POSITION AND ANY MATCH COMPETITORS MUST USE NRA BPTR "STICK EM IN THE GROUND" CROSS STICKS. Empty chamber indicators are mandatory. There are no shooter classes.

**Any or position entry?** If there are a minimum of 10 position shooters, there will be a National Championship for position. If there are fewer than 10 shooters in the position championship, then all shooters will compete in the any national championship. Shooters will be advised.

**The match director will select a jury in the event of a shooter concern. There is \$20 nonrefundable fee for a challenge.**

**The match is limited to 40 shooters. After 40 shooters have signed up any additional shooters will be placed on a waiting list.**

**LUNCH will be provided on Tuesday and Wednesday. Jack Odor and SPG/Larry Baker donated Jersey Mikes Italian sandwiches on Tuesday and Wyoming Sight Drifter/Steve Anderson, and Buffalo Arms will donate lunch on Wednesday. Many thanks for their generosity.**

**PIT DUTY:** All competitors are required to perform pit duty which includes spotting hits, setting targets up and putting targets away after the match.
